



Best of the West Futurity Series Rules and Regulations 2010

1. The "Best Of The West Futurity Series" will hold a Stallion Service Auction to fund their annual Futurity Series. The auction will take place during the "Heritage Ranch Equine Affair" at Heritage Ranch on 23 January 2010.
 - a. Bids will be accepted from 12:00 until 5:00PM. At that time all bidding sheets will be closed except in the case of a bidding war. If there is a bidding war, the bidder who offers up the highest bid will be the resulting buyer of the breed.
2. The Stallion Service Auction will be for the 2010 breeding year. Only stallions standing in Utah or owned by Utah residents are eligible.
3. Classes for futurity to be held in September of 2010 in Utah are:

4. The age split will be defined as such:
 - i. Senior Weanlings are those born between January 1st and March 31st.
 - ii. Junior Weanlings are those born April 1st or after.
5. Entry fees will be added back to the appropriate class. The amount of Stallion Service Auction sales will determine how much additional monies will be added.
6. The club retains 25% of all money earned from the Stallion Service Auction and entry fees. This money is to be used to pay for arena rental fees, judge fees, supplies, and any additional operating expenses. The remaining 75% is paid out to the winners of the Stallion Service Auction Futurity.
7. Stallion owners have the right to purchase their own breed back from the SSA. A stallion's breeding must be sold to make foals of that breeding season eligible. Breeds can be purchased up to the start of the 2010 Stallion Service Auction Futurity. Once the show has started, 2010 Stallion breeds are no longer available for purchase.
8. Stallions will be offered for no less than one-half their normal breeding fee. If stallion stands for private treaty, the minimum bid can be no less than \$250.
9. Stallion owners purposely entering their stallion after May 31st will have to pay 75% of the breed fee to buy them back.
10. The Best of the West will try to create an impartial committee to help hire judges. A board member will be appointed to oversee this committee.
11. The owner of a stallion whose breeding sells will receive one entry at half price for the resulting foal to be used during its weanling or yearling year only.
12. The buyer of the breeding will receive one entry at half price for the resulting foal to be used during its weanling or yearling year only.
13. Entries must be post marked by September 3rd, 2010. Late entries will be accepted up until the day of the show at double the normal entry fee. Late entries must be paid in cash so that payouts for futurities may be made the day of the show.
